## DIRECTIONS

**From Airport to Glenalmond House:** Take either a taxi to Glenalmond House - 25 minutes, or the Airport Express bus into the city centre and then a local bus (see numbers below) or taxi to Glenalmond House

**From Waverley Train Station to Glenalmond House:** Take a taxi or from Princes Street, take a bus to Glenalmond House. Bus stop is opposite the Scott Monument and bus numbers are: 3, 3A, 29, 31, 37 or 47. From North Bridge, all these numbers plus 7, 8 and 49

**From Glenalmond House to Edinburgh Royal Infirmary:** Distance is approximately one mile. Bus numbers 8, 49
